Suggested Use

Creative Challenges: Ask learners to write essays, create art, or design infographics that highlight the solutions.

School Campaigns: Use the cards as the foundation for campaigns or events to promote environmental awareness and action.

Green Cities for a Sustainable Future

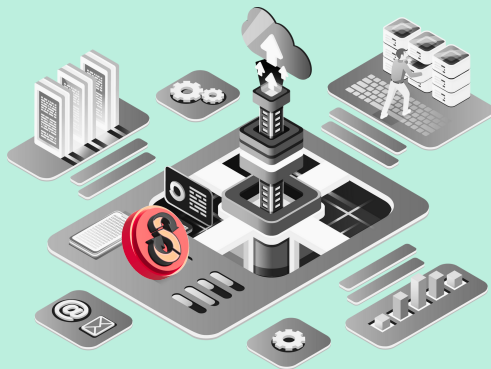
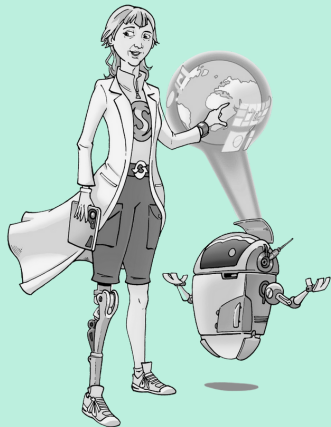
Urban areas are planting green roofs and building vertical gardens to combat pollution and create habitats for wildlife. Imagine how your city could look with more greenery.

Ocean Cleanup Technology

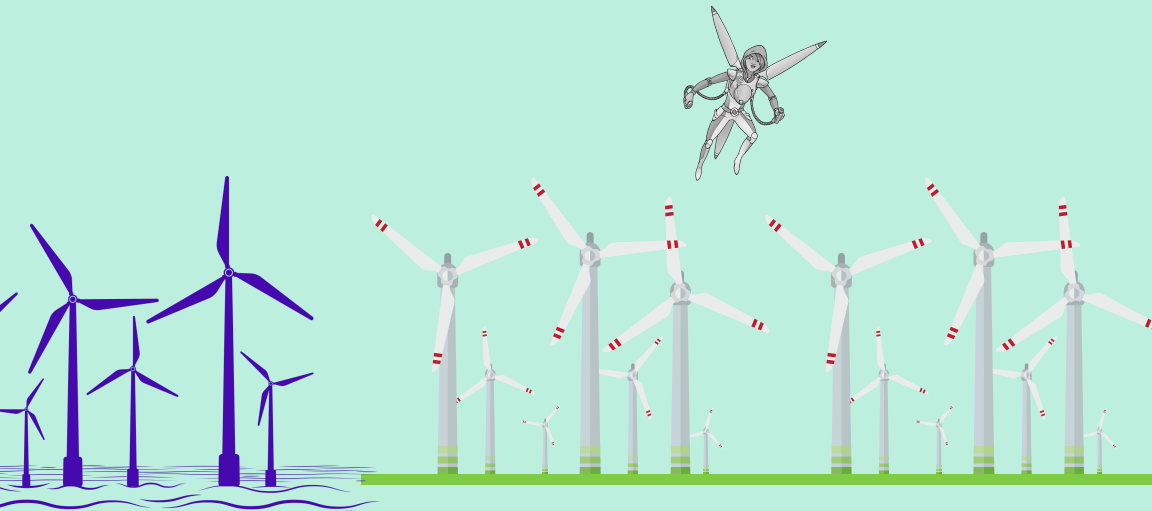
Devices like floating barriers are being used to remove plastic from oceans and rivers. How might you contribute to keeping waterways clean?

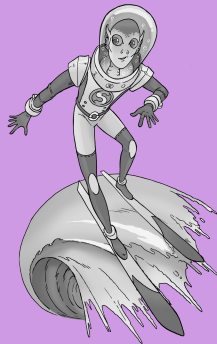
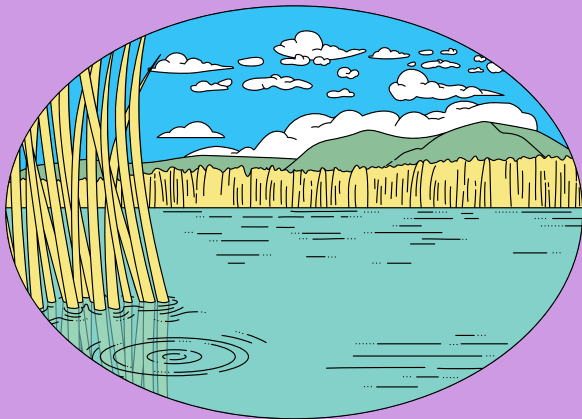
Around the world, young people are leading campaigns for sustainability and climate justice. What issue would you advocate for to bring hope to your community?

be protected or restored to help balance the environment?**

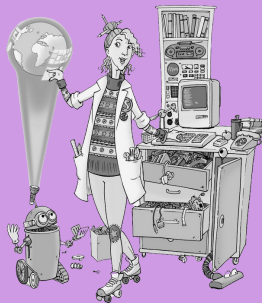
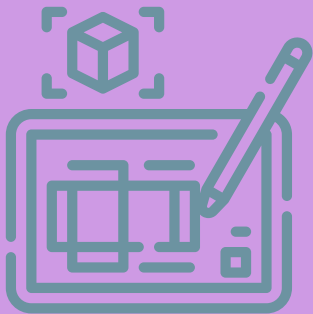

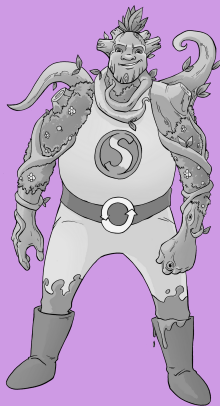
Products designed for reuse or repair reduce waste and save resources.

What items in your life could be reused, repaired, or repurposed?





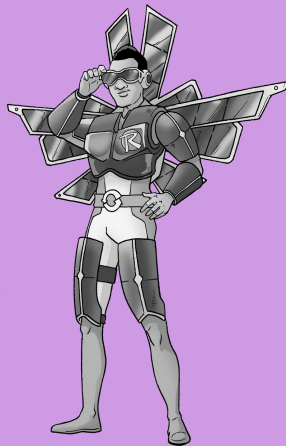
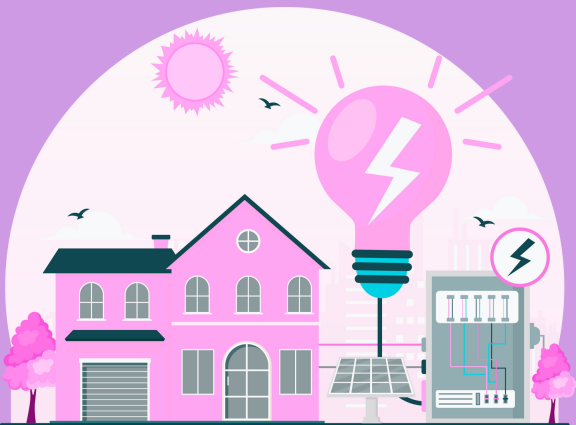
**Sustainable Farming Practices

Community Energy Projects

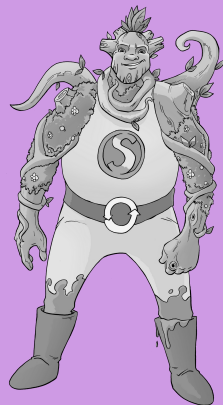
Some communities create shared solar or wind power systems to provide clean energy for everyone. Could a project like this help people in your area?
